About the tour:

Explore the historical monuments in Delhi, witness the immortal beauty of the Taj Mahal in Agra and then embark to Rajasthan. Sand dunes, wooded hills, amazing lakes, palaces, rugged forts, quiet villages, harsh sunlight, the cool evening breeze are all there in abundance of Rajasthan. Enter in Gujarat certainly a place like no other when it comes history, culture and architectural brilliance. You will visit Hindu Temples at Somnath & Dwarka, Jain temples at Palitana on the Shatrunjaya hills, safari in Sasan Gir Wildlife Sanctuary, Junagarh ancient fortified city rich in myth and legend & Rajkot the former colonial state.

Outline Itinerary

Day 01: Arrive Delhi

On arrival at Delhi International airport meet with our office executive assistance and transfer to hotel check in.

Later city tour of Delhi, visiting landmark of Old Delhi which include Red Fort, Jama Masjid, Chandni chowk & Khari Baoli Spice Market. Cycle Rickshaw ride in Chandni Chowk. Sightseeing of New Delhi which includes Qutab Minar, Humayun Tomb, Lotus Temple & VVIP areas President House, Parliament & India Gate. Overnight at hotel.

Day 02: Delhi - Agra (204kms/ 4hrs approx)

Breakfast at hotel drive to Agra check in at hotel.

Afternoon city tour of Agra visit Taj Mahal, Agra Fort and Itmad-ud-Daula Tomb. Overnight at hotel.

Day 03: Agra - Fatehpur Sikri - Abhaneri - Jaipur (245kms/ 5hrs approx)

Breakfast at hotel drive to Jaipur enroute visit Fatehpur Sikri the 16th century ghost town and Abhaneri a small village popular for the amazing step wells and Temple. Further drive to Jaipur check in at hotel.

Evening explore the pink city and visit the colorful bazaars. As per your interest wrap up your day by watching Bollywood movie at the opulent Rajmandir Cinema. Overnight at hotel.

Day 04: Jaipur

Breakfast at hotel. Visit the majestic Amer Fort and Jaigarh Fort. Enjoy Elephant ride at Amber Fort.

Later visit the city monuments including City Palace, Observatory, Palace of Winds, Albert Hall Museum and Birla Temple. Overnight at hotel.

Day 05: Jaipur - Pushkar - Jodhpur (330km/ 6hr approx)

Breakfast at hotel drive to Jodhpur via visiting Pushkar. On arrival check in at hotel. Rest time free and easy to relax. Overnight at hotel.

Day 06: Jodhpur

Breakfast at hotel full day city tour visiting Mehrangarh Fort, Jaswant Thanda, Umaid Bhawan Palace and museum. Excursion visit to Mandore garden & Chatris. Overnight at hotel.

Day 07: Jodhpur - Ranakpur - Udaipur (260kms/ 5hrs approx)

Breakfast at hotel drive to Udaipur enroute visit Ranakpur Jain Temple or Kumbhalgarh Fort as per your interest. On arrival check in at hotel. Later watch folk performance Dharohar at Bagor ki Haveli. Overnight at hotel.

Day 08: Udaipur

Breakfast at hotel full day city tour of Udaipur visit City palace & museum, gardens, temples and havelis. Sunset boat ride on the Lake Pichhola. Overnight at hotel.

Day 09: Udaipur - Mount Abu (170kms/ 4hrs approx)

Breakfast at hotel, drive to Mount Abu check in at hotel.

Mount Abu is a hill station, near the Gujarat border. Set on a high rocky plateau in the Aravalli Range and surrounded by forest, it offers a relatively cool climate and views over the arid plains below. In the center of town, Nakki Lake is a popular spot for boating. Close by are the centuries-old Dilwara Temples, ornately carved from white marble and of great spiritual importance. Overnight at hotel.

Day 10: Mount Abu - Ahmedabad (230kms/ 5hrs approx)

Breakfast at hotel morning free to explore the surrounding. Afternoon drive to Ahmedabad check in at hotel. Overnight at hotel.

Day 11: Ahmedabad

Breakfast at hotel full day city tour of Ahmedabad home to several interesting museums. Many of Ahmedabad buildings bear the signatures of world-renowned architects like Le Corbusier, Louis Khan, Doshi and Correa. Visit the Shaking minarets, Calico textile museum, Sabarmati ashram, Vishala vichar museum and Kite museum. Later visit the famous Law gardens (for handicrafts) and C.J road for shopping. Overnight at hotel.

Day 12: Ahmedabad – Bhavnagar (175kms/ 3hrs approx)

Breakfast at hotel, drive to Bhavnagar check in at hotel. Afternoon city tour visiting Gandhi Smriti - a living tribute to Gandhiji. Barton Library & Museum - among the oldest monuments in Bhavnagar, this library is a popular among men of all age group. Old age people sit and read newspaper, magazines, and dailies to spend their time. A Museum containing old books, manuscripts, arms and armor and rare coins belonging to rulers of Bhavnagar. Overnight at hotel.

Day 13: Bhavnagar – Palitana - Junagarh (215kms/ 4hrs approx)

Breakfast at hotel drive to Junagadh enroute visit Palitana Temples Palitana located 51 km south west of Bhavnagar. Known for being the largest cluster of Jain temples. There are in total 863 temples from base to the peak of the Shatrunjaya hill, where the Palitana temples are located. The path is climbed through 3950 steps spanning 3.5 km up the Shatrunjaya Hills. The construction of temples of Palitana spanned over a period of 900 years and was structured in two phases.

Continue drive to Junagadh check in at hotel. Rest time free and easy to relax. Overnight at hotel.

Day 14: Junagarh - Sasan Gir (70kms/ 1.3hrs approx)

Breakfast at hotel, visit Junagarh an ancient fortified city rich in myth and legend, Junagadh lies at the foot of the temple-studded Girnar Hill. It derives its name from the 'old fort', which circles the medieval town.

The Girnar Hills that landscape Junagadh are a holy sanctuary to the Jains. The history of Mount Girnar dates back to the awesome empire of Ashoka, one of India's greatest emperors. Ashoka inscribed 14 edicts on a huge boulder en-route to Mt. Girnar peak. Junagadh's main feature is the Uperkot fort (upper fort), a somber and inaccessible fortress.

Afternoon drive to Sasan Gir National Park check in at hotel. Dinner & overnight at hotel.

Day 15: Sasan Gir - Somnath (60kms/ 1hrs approx)

Breakfast at hotel followed by safari in Gir Wildlife Sanctuary

Sprawling in an area of 1424 sq. kms, Gir with its dry deciduous forest is a luxuriantly rich ecosystem endowed with floral and faunal plentitude. Thirty species of mammals, twenty species of reptiles, several species of insects and birds are found here. The forest is the only place in the world, outside Africa, where the lion can be seen in its natural habitat. The forest also harbors a number of smaller birds and animals. Other predators are the panther and the hyena. The largest Indian deer, Sambhar, Chital (spotted deer), Nilgai (blue bull), Chinkara and the unique Chowsingha (four horned antelope) are found here along with the bear and the long tailed langur.

Gir is also one of the finest bird sanctuaries in India. Some of the typical birds of Gir are the crested serpent eagle, crested hawk eagle, brown fish owl, king vulture, jungle quail, paradise flycatcher, pygmy woodpecker, hard headed oriole etc. Adholia, Valadera, Ratanghuna and Pilipat are rewarding places for bird watching. Another attraction is a crocodile farm developed in the forest.

After Lunch drive to Somnath check in at hotel. Rest time to relax and walk on the beach. Overnight at hotel.

Day 16: Somnath - Probandar - Dwarka (255kms/ 5hrs approx)

Breakfast at hotel, visit Somnath temple (Jyotirlinga), Paanch Pandav Caves, Somnath Beach and many temples in and around. Late afternoon drive to Dwarka check in at hotel. Overnight at Hotel.

Day 17: Dwarka - Rajkot (230kms/ 5hrs approx)

Breakfast at hotel visit Nageshwar temple (Jyotirlinga). Dwarka is an ancient city known as a Hindu pilgrimage site. The ancient Dwarkadhish Temple has an elaborately tiered main shrine, a carved entrance and a black-marble idol of Lord Krishna. Dwarka Beach and nearby Dwarka Lighthouse offer views of the Arabian Sea. Southeast, Gaga Wildlife Sanctuary protects migratory birds and endangered species like the Indian wolf.

Afternoon drive to Rajkot check in at hotel. Overnight at hotel.

Day 18: Rajkot - Delhi or Mumbai (flight)

Breakfast at hotel. Visit Jubilee Garden - a large and open park area in Rajkot. It features many monuments of colonial time. The centre of the city garden is the Connaught Hall and other notable places of interest near the Garden include the historic Mohandas Gandhi High School, Kaba Gandhi No Delo, Rashtriya Shala, Watson Museum, Lang Library, and Rotary Midtown Library. Watson Museum has a great collection of precious objects of colonial period and is considered to be one the finest in Gujarat. It was made to commemorate the works of the then administrator Colonel James Watson in 1888. The museum also houses a varied collection of old artefacts from the ancient city of Mohenjodaro.

Later as per flight schedule transfer to airport to board flight for onward destination.
